

26-27 FREIRE CHARTER SCHOOL WILMINGTON BUS SCHEDULES/TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Hello Freire Wilmington Students and Families -

We have spent the last few weeks gathering data and feedback from our students, families, and the bus companies we partner with. As promised, we are going to make some adjustments that will allow us to more efficiently serve our community. Below are the updated routes, times, and stops for each of our 5 buses. Please find your bus/stop and note the pick up times.

There is one major change that I would like to note, which is that the Bowlarama stop that was previously a stop on Bus #1, will now be on Bus #2. This will allow us to more efficiently pick up and drop off students.

Private Car Pickup/Drop off

Our 9th - 12th grade students can be dropped off and picked up at our main campus 201 W. 14th Street Wilmington, DE 19801 front door entrance of the school building. Our 8th Grade academy students can be dropped off at 1200 N. French Street Wilmington, DE 19802 and proceed through the lobby to the 7th floor. We kindly ask that you pull into an empty parking space near both buildings and do not block traffic.

DART

Please see Mr. Chris or Ms. Pam during dismissal in the front lobby for students who need a dart pass. **These will be distributed on Tuesday of each week.**

Walkers/Scooters/Bicycles UPDATE

Students are NOT permitted to take personal electric scooters to/from school due to safety concerns. These devices cannot be stored within the building and can not be plugged in and charged. If students are using these devices in an unsafe manner, the Code of Conduct will be applied.
